January through March

- Snow removal

- Soft trail maintenance
- Tree watering as needed
- Stump removal

April through June

- Snow removal
- Fertilizer application
- Aerate
- Overseed/Topdress
- Irrigation checks and repairs
- Turf and shrub bed herbicide applications
- Replant shrub beds where needed
- Plant annual flowers at City Hall, Ralston Central and Olde Town including baskets
- Playground checks and repairs
- Mulch trees and shrub beds
- Tree planting
- Pest Control Management on trees
- Tree wrap removal
- Tree Stake Removal
- Tree watering as needed
- Begin Native Mowing operations
- Arvada Reservoir opens for the season
- Maintenance Contract begins
- Soft trail maintenance

July through September

- Mowing
- Continue Native mowing operations
- Irrigation checks and repairs
- Turf and shrub bed herbicide applications
- Playground checks and repairs
- Prune low hanging limbs on snow routes
- Concrete trail repairs

- Aerate
- Soft trail maintenance
- Tree removal as needed
- Tree pruning
- Tree Watering
- Dead Tree inventory/inspection

October through December

- Prune low hanging limbs on snow routes, this includes private trees overhanging City walks
- End mowing season
- End Native mowing operations
- Remove annual flowers / turn beds over and chip
- Turf and shrub bed herbicide applications
- Aerate
- Overseed/Topdress
- Pruning of trees and shrubs,
- Pruning and cleanup on Medians
- Snow removal
- Concrete trail repairs
- Leaf cleanup
- Maintenance Contract ends
- Soft trail maintenance
